The BMC offers nine Wednesday morning concerts per year, free and open to the public, living up to its mission of fostering music appreciation in the community.

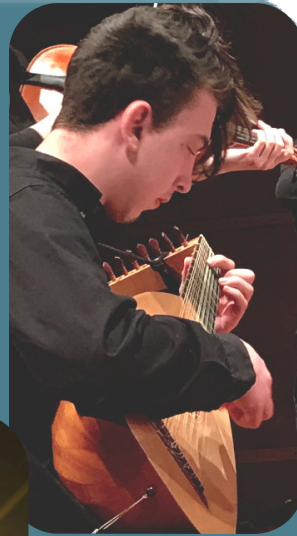
